




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Anugraha Bhashanam

Perform Karma with Detachment (From March 2015 Tattvaloka)

It is natural for man to desire happiness always and avoid sorrow. An illusion that such happiness is derived from worldly comforts haunts him till the dawn of viveka (discrimination). But



the Sastras and the experiences of jnanis stress that real happiness is obtained only through Atma jnana.

However, it is not possible for all human beings to withdraw the mind immediately from external objects and direct attention to the Atman.

That is why Sastras teach men, through injunctions and prohibitions, on how to cultivate bhakti and sraddha while performing actions. If one adheres to this approach, the mind slowly becomes pure.

Thus cleansed, the mind will withdraw from external

preoccupations and begin to turn inward. For such a sadhaka, the obstacles that hide jnana will gradually disappear. Through the blessings of the jnanaguru, vairagya (determination), involvement towards Atma jnana and mental peace will dawn on him automatically.

Historic Kashmir Yatra of Sri Sannidhanam

With the blessing and directive of Sringeri Jagadguru

Shankaracharya Sri Sri Bharati Tirtha Mahaswamiji, Jagadguru Sri Sri Vidhushekhara Bharati





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Mahaswamiji undertook a 3-day Vijaya Yatra to Jammu and Kashmir and performed the Pratishtha Kumbhabhisheka of Sri Sharada temple at Teetwal.

Sri Sannidhanam departed from Sringeri on the morning of June 4, 2023 and arrived at the Srinagar airport to a reverential reception. Sri Sannidhanam then arrived at Tangdhar (170 km from Srinagar and located alongside the LoC) the same evening and was accorded a devout



welcome the by district Kupwara authorities and the members of Save Committee Sharada led by Sri Ravinder Pandita. Sri Sannidhanam then arrived at Teetwal and performed Yantra Pratishtha at the Sharada temple, Later Sannidhanam Sri performed Chandramoulishwara Puja at Tangdhar

The following morning (June 5), Sri Sannidhanam performed the Pratishtha Kumbhabhisheka of Sri Sharada at the temple located 40 KM Sri from Sharada Sarvajna Peetham. Sri Sannidhanam then graced the Sabha organised on the occasion of the

Kumbhabhisheka and blessed the devotees with an Anugraha Bhashanam explaining the connection between Sringeri and Kashmir, as well as the greatness of Sri Sharada, the divinity of knowledge. Sri Sannidhanam commended the government authorities as well as the Army personnel for making various arrangements pertaining to the smooth conduct of the entire event. Sri Sannidhanam had a Darshan at Kheer Bhavani temple at Kupwara then returned to Srinagar by late evening and performed the Chandramoulishwara Puja.





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On June 6, Sri Sannidhanam arrived at the famous Sri Shankaracharya Hill in Srinagar and offered an elaborate Puja to Sri Jyestheshwara. Later, Sri Sannidhanam addressed the gathering in an Anugraha Bhashanam conveying the need for having faith in Bhagavan and for living as noble citizens of the country. Sri Sannidhanam also praised the army personnel who are even



ready to make the supreme sacrifice of laying down their own lives for the safety of others. Calling for overall inclusive development of the Kashmir valley, Sri Sannidhanam stressed the importance of youth to become nation builders and responsible citizens.

Later Sri Sannidhanam graced the Raj Bhavan to a devout welcome by Lieutenant Governor of Jammu and Kashmir Sri Manoj Sinha. Sri Sannidhanam returned to Sringeri the same evening, thus completing a historic Kashmir Yatra.





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His Holiness Sri Mahasannidhanam's Aashirvachanam:

Kashmir is the crown of Bharat Maata. Without the crown no one can be King. Without Kashmir, there's no Bharat. Hence it is the duty of all Citizens of India to come / visit Kashmir. There's a



remarkable connection between Kashmir Adi Bhagawan Shankaracharya ji. In the life of Adi Shankaracharya the ascending of Sarvagnana (Seat Peetham omniscience) is а very important event. The Peetham Sarvagnana located in Kashmir near Srinagar and Bhagawatpada Shankaracharya ascended that Sarvagnana Peetham. Bhagawan Shankaracharya also came

to this temple of Lord Shiva (Jyesteshwara)& performed Puja. Hence to come here and perform puja is of great significance to us.

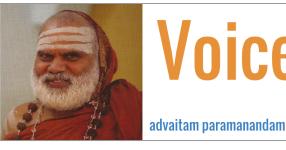

Bhagawati Shree Sharadaamba whom we address as gynanadevata, the Goddess of knowledge. Which is the most valuable object in this world? Gynana(knowledge). There's nothing more valuable than knowledge. Bhagwan himself says in Bhagavad Gita न हि ज्ञानेन सदृश्म् पवित्रमिह विद्यते. There's nothing in this world as sacred as knowledge. This is the purport of that statement. What's the difference between stone and human beings? A stone doesn't possess knowledge. Other living beings possess. We call stone nirjeev jad. It doesn't possess knowledge. However living beings possess knowledge. Even amongst living beings, human beings possess greater amounts of knowledge. Only humans possess discriminatory knowledge- what to do , what not to do. Animals possess knowledge. However, knowledge of humans is higher and decisive. It must be done this way. Only this will yield good results.

This must not be done. Only humans have such discrimination knowledge. Before embarking on any work, we should first understand it fully. Every task commences with a sound understanding of it. That's why shastras state prakriya (procedure).

ज्ञाति इच्छती यतेते तच्छ क्रियाण.





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It's purpose is that every human first tries to understand the task at hand before commencing to work on it. First gain knowledge. Then I desire to perform the task I'll do this work. We refer to this as sankalpa (resolve). First we understand the task. Next we must put in the required efforts finally be exerting physical effort, we either create something or accomplish something in this world. Hence, knowledge is the source of every perfect action. This knowledge is most difficult to attain and also preeminent. That's why Bhagwan says in Gita

न हि ज्ञान सदृश्म पवित्रमिह विदयते।

How do we attain this knowledge? Only through the grace of Bhagawati Sharadaamba. Humans possess such knowledge. For instance, an elephant possesses immense physical strength. Where's the strength of humans in comparison to that of an elephant? It's almost negligible. However, what does a human do? He can even control the mighty elephant. Elephants behave as per man's command. Where did man get such capacity from? Through the power of intellect Man knows how to tame the elephant. How can I extract work? Humans possess this knowledge.

Man does not possess physical strength equivalent to elephants but has power of knowledge. Consider an instance of a bird flying in the sky. Man cannot fly. Like it. However, man can create vehicles that can fly in the sky. Humans have this capability. All this is possible only through knowledge. Therefore this knowledge is what forms the substratum of this world. This knowledge is gained by the grace of Goddess Sharadaamba.

Goddess Sharadaamba is divinity of all forms of knowledge.if we possess knowledge, all other objects are effortlessly attained such knowledge is extremely important for us. After the Kumbhabhishek, we offered a prayer at the sanctum of Devi. This prayer was composed by our parapara Guru Jagadguru Sri Sri Sachchidanand Shivaabhinavanrissimha Bharathi Mahaswamiji, who was the 33rd Acharya of Dakshinamaya Sringeri Sharada Peetham. I offered that prayer today..

O! Devi Grant me single pointed focus in the execution of my duties - this is the first prayer. To discharge duties with resolute focus , our body must firstly be strong and in good health. Therefore, bestow good health upon me. Grant me a long lifespan to engage in noble deeds and to discharge my duties as well. May I beget noble fame through discharge of noble deeds .

Grant me fame that spans the entire universe. When will we acquire such fame? When we engage in good deeds. Therefore you make me engaged in noble deeds and also bestow upon me such fame .

May my mind never incline towards sinful deeds. Those deeds which are against the injunctions of the shastras and society. When my mind gravitates towards such deeds, restrain my mind O Devi, and restore it to goodness. Bless me that my mind must never venture into such unwanted terrain. Bestow upon me noble associations. I must always remain in association with noble people. If I remain in association with noble people, I'll also become noble. If I associate with wickedness, I'll also acquire wicked tendencies. This is the nature of human beings. They acquire qualities of those with whom they are associated. So bestow upon me with noble associations so that I may lead a noble life .









May I always listen to exhalted stories . We beseech bhagwan for this. The main source of all work is knowledge, intellect. This is how his Holiness, the 33rd Acharyal beseeched the Devi. This prayer is essential for every individual. This prayer can not be restricted to a select few . It cannot be said that this prayer is not applicable to others . Not can it be confined to people of a specification, kingdom . We cannot say that this prayer is not essential to the next generation. For the upliftment of every nation and every individual such prayer is utmost necessity

It's solely through Devi's grace that we obtain the most invaluable knowledge. Today this place is blessed with the sanctity of Goddess Sharadaamba, the divinity of all knowledge.









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
