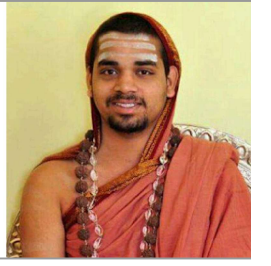

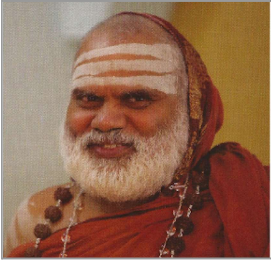

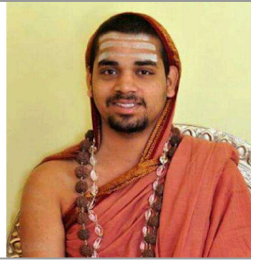

O Sharada with a golden complexion, who confers blessings, such as heavenly abode, mount the gold chariot and protect all!



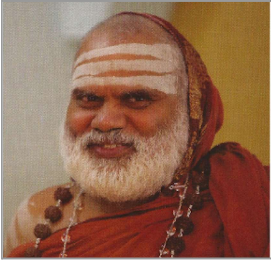
भक्तप्रिये भद्रदात्रि भक्तानामभयप्रदे ।

With devotion that pleases her, I submit this gold chariot to the Goddess who showers welfare and congers fearlessness on her devotees.

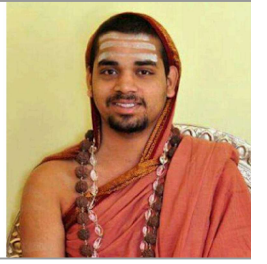
